



Self-Directed Shoot

Your task is to **learn something about photography that you've always wanted to know** and put that learning into practice. In other words, do some research/investigation into a theme, genre, style of topic of photography so that you essentially teach yourself and then share with so we can shoot it in the future (shoot it if you can). You will share your learning with our class by teaching this to us.

You need to **submit a proposal** to Mrs. A about your idea for your self-directed shoot. Your proposal needs to describe your idea and how you can achieve it.

You will complete this research and shoot in your own environment (aka no specific class for it). Keep in mind this is a major project, and one that requires research and detail.

Be prepared to show us this shoot and PPT on _____, and to teach us what you did/learned.

You will need to have:

- A PPT that details the research part (i.e.: slides that teach us about this topic/style/genre in terms of what we need to know to repeat this topic/style/genre)
- Slides that outline the key things a photographer needs to know to successfully do this shoot themselves
- Images from your shoot, both good and emerging, to show us what you tried, what worked, what to do differently
- A slide of your best image from the shoot
- A final slide with your self-critique of that image.
